





When questioned as to how the landlords could be exterminated, she stated that some week on a national scale they could be met with bullets instead of checks. also stated that the revolutionaries can cause complete anarcy because "we" have people training in utilities in departments where "we" can cause complete anarchy and there is nothing they can do. stated that and that there was some discussion of carpools to participate in the demonstrations at that institution. It was also mentioned that the group must organize to fight with its brothers at San Francisco State.
