The April 18 Coordinating Committee Meeting and the May 5 General Meeting, persuant to the Free U's existing policy of resistance to conscription, ratified the organized non-violent resistance to National Service Foundation.

On Sunday, May 26, The National Service Foundation will hold its rally at Frost Amphitheater, Stanford University. This is the big one; if this rally is successful it will be considered a mandate to go ahead with their tragically ill-conceived program. President Johnson will give the o.k., and General Hershey will revlove selectively with channeled joy.

We will culminate two months of active resistance to this idea which holds such great potential for evil, with a non-violent counter-demonstration. We shall picket, and try to place our leaflet, which explains our opposition, into the hands of every attendee. The pre-demonstration meeting to explain strategy and tactics, and to organize teams, will be held on Monday, May 20, at 17:30 p.m., in the Free U Store.

If you cannot make this meeting, be at the Frost Amphitheater on Sunday, May 26, at 1:00 p.m. We will give you a sign or an assignment.
